## "I lift up my eyes to the hills. From where does my help come? My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth." Psalm 121:1-2

#### King Road Church,

I've recently been working through Eugene Peterson's book, *A Long Obedience in the Same Direction*, which asks a timeless question: Where do you look for help? Peterson explores the Songs of Ascent (Psalms 120-134), which were sung by Jewish pilgrims journeying to Jerusalem for annual feasts. In those days, travelers often looked to the "high places"—hills filled with shrines to various gods. The psalmist, however, reminds the people that these idols offer no real salvation. Our help doesn't come *from* the hills, but from the Lord who *made* the hills. Our help comes from the Creator of heaven and earth.

This summer, we are hearing stories of campers who are realizing where true help comes from. A coach in Manitoba recently shared about an individual who was participating for their third year of camp. Known as being disruptive and uninterested in faith, their presence was challenging. During an intense moment of play, one of our coaches held them

accountable for poor sportsmanship. After taking some time to reflect, this camper rejoined the team and later shared their gratitude for how his teammates gave him a second chance. This proved to be a turning point as they began to listen, track with the teaching, accept a Bible and ultimately make a decision to follow Jesus.

A coach in Saskatchewan shared a powerful story about another camper from a non-Christian family who, it seemed, had never heard about God before. Throughout the week, he learned about the person of Jesus—His intentionality, love, grace, and faithfulness. The teaching resonated so deeply that he began trying to convince his skeptical parents that God was real, even as they tried to teach him otherwise. By the end of the week, his coaches gave him his first Bible with guidance on how to read it, and he prayed to commit his life to following Jesus.

I get to begin each week reading the stories of campers deciding to look to the only one who can truly help us in any circumstance. May you be encouraged and reminded of this truth.
