

Dear Friends,

Thank you for your ongoing prayers and support in the ministry God has called us to with MAF!

Unexpected changes in our lives can sometimes cause uncertainty and worry, but they also provide an amazing opportunity to see God's faithfulness even when we don't understand what He is doing. That has definitely been the case for us this past year!

While I (Kalvin) was able to serve in Africa twice this past year, we didn't end up going as a family as previously expected. We have seen the Lord's sovereignty and goodness in allowing us more time in Canada to support our children in their various stages of life and studies. This has also allowed me to jump back into flight instructing during a time when the program needed instructional staff. We have been able to continue to serve our local church in Three Hills which has been a blessing for us. We are thankful for this body of believers that faithfully meet to worship Christ and hear solid

teaching from His Word. It has given us a renewed longing to see the Church in Canada and around the world strengthened in order to bring greater glory to Christ.

It was a special privilege for me to spend two months in Chad this summer and witness the new work that the Lord is doing in regions of the country that were formerly so closed to the Gospel! In addition, I again saw the great need that exists across the mission field for more workers, and it reminded me why the work at Prairie Aviation Training Centre (PATC) is so vital in equipping pilots and mechanics for service. MAF has asked if I would be willing to complete several additional trips to Africa next year, so we are praying for wisdom in this and the timing involved. We are blessed to be a part of both sides of the MAF ministry—helping to equip new workers, while also being able to periodically go overseas when needed.

This week we were reminded while reading an MAF publication, of the work being done by graduates of ours who now serve in South Sudan. It was exciting





to read of their involvement in supporting Gospel outreach by flying evangelist teams, along with their supplies and thousands of solar-powered radios that are being used to spread the Good News across that nation!

As we continue to serve in Three Hills, I have appreciated more opportunities to get to know students than I previously could as director of the program. Sometimes this involves sitting over a cup of coffee or just discussing what is happening in their lives while we prepare for our flights. We know the Lord has sovereignly brought each one of them here.

Much of my instructional time has been focused on training students in various aircraft types as they work toward their commercial license. A particular privilege has been carrying out much of the mountain training for the program. We expect most graduates will at some point end up flying in mountainous regions of the world and off of challenging airstrips. We therefore feel it is crucial that we give them a good understanding of the risks involved and allow them to practice this under our supervision in a fairly controlled environment.

I was recently asked by MAF to carry out a training module for mission candidates who have begun working in the aviation industry and are now hoping to join MAF. My role is to spend a week with the candidates, providing some flight training as well as an initial assessment of their capability before they move on to the next stage of evaluations with MAF. It is a privilege to be a small part of the preparation journey they are on toward service wherever God leads them!

We look forward to having most of our kids here this holiday season.
